Title: Combination Technician

Overview

CTC is seeking a reliable self-motivated individual to join our team as a Combination Technician and be trained to be our lead remote site technician in Cordova, Alaska. This role will be responsible for supporting all remote site facilities to maintain our cellular and microwave networks. This role will work directly with our Wireless Foreman for training and interfaces with our wireless and networking teams. The successful candidate will be friendly, a good communicator, detail oriented, and a problem solver with the ability to learn and support technology services.

This job requires regular overtime, tower climbing, routine helicopter travel to remote sites, potential overnight travel, and ongoing training for safety and technology. This is a great opportunity to be the local wireless hero and support your community's communication needs throughout Cordova and the Prince William Sound.

Responsibilities

After extensive training, this combination technician will be responsible for all technical aspects of remote sites, including: power generation and storage, microwave communications, wireless radio area networks, tower management, refueling, and general maintenance. Physical exertion for this position will range from light to heavy. The successful candidate will learn and perform the following duties:

- A. Lead the planning and delivery of general site maintenance.
- B. Lead capital projects for remote sites.
- C. Collaborate with vendors to maintain and support remote sites.
- D. Manage site refueling.
- E. Maintain tower antennas and wiring.
- F. Maintain remote building structures.
- G. Maintain remote site cabling for Coax, Copper, and Fiber.
- H. Maintain micro grid power systems (propane generators, battery banks, solar, direct power).
- I. Primary support for remote site power and communication issues.
- J. Able to work under stressful situations. Memory for and attention to many details.
- K. Learn and support the following technologies: General Networking and IP Management, Radio Area Networks, Aviat Microwave, Axis Webcams, Eltek Power, Polar Power, SiteBoss, Wireless Boosters, Anritsu and Fluke Test Tools, Solar Winds Monitoring, Basic SSH.
- L. Participate in trainings for Tower Climbing, Wilderness Safety, OSHA Safety, and maintain coinciding certifications.
- M. It is the employee's responsibility to keep current on all company policies, bylaws, tariffs, and regulations.
- N. Fill out detailed daily time sheets describing all work performed.
- O. Snow and ice removal from towers and site buildings as needed.
- P. May be called on to work in any kind of weather.
- Q. Such other duties as may be assigned.
